

Journal Editorial Policies

Peer Review

- The journal follows the Double-Blind Peer Review system.
- The editors primarily consider the submitted articles for the confirmation of the standard and the scope of the journal. If any submitted article fails to fulfil primary standard, the same will be rejected, and the author will be promptly communicated about the decision.
- If the editors are satisfied, two reviewers are selected for detailed consideration of the articles.
- Receipt of works is acknowledged instantly and automatically via the system.

Review period

We do NOT have any system for quick or rapid review, nor do we encourage it. The decision on a submitted article along with reviewers' comments is communicated to the author within 3 months. Authors should not send any query before the period is over. However, **after three months of submission, if no decision is taken, authors can naturally withdraw and submit elsewhere.**

Length of the Article

Manuscripts should be submitted online and the usual length of an article should be between 4000 and 6000 words, typed with double-space in the MS word-file format. Book Reviews should usually be within 1500-3000 words. All citations and bibliographic entries contained in the articles must comply to the 9th Edition of the *MLA Handbook*.
