## Eligibility (A or B):

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National

Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. program prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal or in the UGC CARE list of journals (UGC Approved List of Journals has been replaced by UGC-CARE list, w.e.f. 14.06.2019, Refer Public Notice on Academic Integrity released by the UGC, New Delhi - Notice No.F.1-1/2018(Journals/CARE); dated 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019) [https://ugccare.unipune.ac.in/site/website/index.aspx]
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programs in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

#### **General Guidelines and Instructions:**

- 1. The eligible and interested persons are required to apply online in the format available on the University Website <u>https://recruitment.gmuniversity.ac.in/</u>. Only online applications will be accepted.
- 2. Incomplete application form without scanned signatures and other mandatory supporting documents shall be summarily rejected. University shall not entertain any correspondence in case of incomplete information and unfurnished supporting documents.
- 3. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate to be called for interview. The short listing of the candidates to be called for interview shall be carried out as per Appendix II Table: 3A of UGC Regulations, 2018. Please refer UGC Regulations 2018 for details about qualifications. The age of superannuation would be as per the rules and regulations of the Government of Odisha (GoO).
- 4. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned in UGC Regulations, 2018/GoO rules are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace marks.
- 5. Only matriculation/SSC certificate/pass certificate issued by the concerned educational board will be considered as proof of date of birth. No other document will be accepted for verification of date of birth.
- 6. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC category should submit proper caste certificate as per the guidelines and the certificate format of the GoO.
- 7. Candidates belonging to SEBC category, but coming in creamy layer will not be entitled to the benefits of reservation and shall have to apply as General Category candidate. In the case of SEBC reservations, recent certificate should be issued from competent authority particularly with reference to Non-creamy layer. Those who fail to submit the required certificate(s) will be treated under General Category, subject to fulfillment of other terms & conditions.
- 8. The candidates applying under PwD Category are required to submit the Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by Government of Odisha/India for this purpose.
- 9. The University reserves the right to:
  - (i) Draw panel(s) for future appointment(s) in the event of non-joining of candidate(s) within the stipulated time.
  - (ii) Not to fill up any of the advertised position(s).
- 10. No correspondence regarding consideration of late applications will be entertained.
- 11. (a) The period spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. degree shall not be considered as research experience.

(b) As per the UGC Communication dated 1 March, 2016, a certificate from the employer/head of the Institution/University has to be uploaded mentioning that *the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree, i.e., for acquiring Ph.D. degree simultaneously without taking any kind of leave may be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/promotion to the post of Associate Professor and above.* 

- 12. Advertisement No., Subject and the level of the Post applied for should be clearly indicated in the online application form. Candidates must ensure the same before applying online.
- 13. Separate online Application Form is required to be filled if intending to apply for multiple subjects [for example, Botany and Biotechnology] to be accessed from the following link: https://recruitment.gmuniversity.ac.in/.
- 14. Applications of the in-service candidates are liable to be rejected, if not routed through the concerned employer. However, candidates may submit advance copies of the application to avoid delay and produce NOC from their employer at the time of interview.

- 15. In-service candidates should ensure that CCRs/Performance Appraisal Report of last five years are received by the Registrar of the University confidentially at least 05 days before the date of interview failing which they may not be awarded the marks/credits towards CCRs as provided in the University Statutes.
- 16. Candidates applying for various faculty positions should go through the essential qualifications and other instructions carefully before applying and also upload/submit scanned copies of all documents in support of their claims.
- 17. The University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s) at any stage in the process of selection in case any inadvertent mistake is detected even after issue of appointment letter.
