Eligibility (A or B):

- (A) (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or in the UGC CARE list of journals (UGC Approved List of Journals has been replaced by UGC-CARE list, w.e.f., 14.06.2019, Refer Public Notice on Academic Integrity released by the UGC, New Delhi - Notice No.F.1-1/2018 (Journals/CARE); dated 14th June, 2019) [<https://ugccare.unipune.ac.in/site/website/index.aspx>] and a total **Research Score of One hundred and twenty (120)** as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 outlined in the UGC notification, New Delhi; dated 18th July 2018.

- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or Research Experience at equivalent levels at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

- (B) An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years of experience.

General Guidelines and Instructions:

1. The eligible and interested persons are required to apply online in the format available on the University Website <https://recruitment.gmuniversity.ac.in/>. Only online applications will be accepted.
2. Incomplete application form without scanned signatures and other mandatory supporting documents shall be summarily rejected. University shall not entertain any correspondence in case of incomplete information and unfurnished supporting documents.
3. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate to be called for interview. Please refer UGC Regulations 2018 for details about qualifications. The age of superannuation would be as per the rules and regulations of the Government of Odisha (GoO).
4. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned in UGC Regulations, 2018/ GoO rules are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace marks.
5. Only matriculation/SSC certificate/pass certificate issued by the concerned educational board will be considered as proof of date of birth. No other document will be accepted for verification of date of

birth.

6. The candidates applying under PwD Category are required to submit the Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by Government of Odisha/India for this purpose.
7. The University reserves the right to:
 - (i) Draw panel(s) for future appointment(s) in the event of non-joining of candidate(s) within the stipulated time.
 - (ii) Not to fill up any of the advertised position(s).
8. No correspondence regarding consideration of late applications will be entertained.
9. (a) The period spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. degree shall not be considered as research experience.

(b) As per the UGC Communication dated 1 March, 2016, a certificate from the employer/ head of the Institution/University has to be uploaded mentioning that *the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree, i.e., for acquiring Ph.D. degree simultaneously without taking any kind of leave may be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/promotion to the post of Associate Professor and above.*
10. Advertisement No., Subject and the level of the Post applied for should be clearly indicated in the online application form. Candidates must ensure the same before applying online.
11. Separate online Application Form is required to be filled up for each post to be accessed from the following link: <https://recruitment.gmuniversity.ac.in/>.
12. Applications of the in-service candidates are liable to be rejected, if not routed through the concerned employer. However, candidates may submit advance copies of the application to avoid delay and produce NOC from their employer at the time of interview.
13. In-service candidates should ensure that CCRs/Performance Appraisal Report of last five years are received by the Registrar of the University confidentially at least 05 days before the date of interview failing which they may not be awarded the marks/credits towards CCRs as provided in the University Statutes.
14. Candidates applying for various faculty positions should go through the essential qualifications and other instructions carefully before applying and also upload/submit scanned copies of all documents in support of their claims.
15. The University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s) at any stage in the process of selection in case any inadvertent mistake is detected even after issue of appointment letter.
16. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at any time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has undesirable/ clandestine antecedents and has suppressed any information, then his/her service shall be terminated.

As per the UGC communication dated 21st September 2016, *"if the M.Phil./Ph.D. degree is awarded by a Foreign University, the Indian Institution considering such a degree shall refer the issue to a Standing Committee constituted by the concerned institution for the purpose of determining the equivalence of the degree awarded by the foreign University."*
21. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor, Gangadhar Meher University in all matters relating to eligibility,

acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection and conduct of interview will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this connection from any individual or his/ her agency.

23. Canvassing in any form will be treated as a disqualification for the post.
24. Candidates must be in sound health. They must, if selected be prepared to undergo such medical examination and satisfy such medical authority as the University may require.
25. No TA/DA will be paid by the University to any candidate for appearing at the interview.
26. In case of any disputes/suits or legal proceedings against the GMU related to the recruitment, the jurisdiction shall be restricted to the courts in Sambalpur, which is the HQs of the University.
