What is the background of this workshop?

- Expand leadership qualities, skill sets and capacity building for geography teachers.

The online workshop is meant for early to mid-career geography teachers at the colleges/universities/institutes of higher learning in India and research scholars interested in careers in teaching. Preference will be given to teachers from non-metropolitan universities and institutions.

The aim is to engage teachers with teaching methodologies, theoretical frameworks, new debates and developments in geography. Enhance skills and capacities for teachers and mentors to create new skills and critical thinking among students.
