Basics of similarity detection and prevention of Plagiarism

This workshop will explore strategies for participants to distinguish correctly between their and others ideas. In fact, the copy paste saga is considered unethical in universities and in the professional world. Further, if you don't give proper credit every time you use another person's words or ideas, even if it is unintentional may lead to serious consequences known as plagiarism. Plagiarism is considered as a form of misconduct and academic dishonesty in scholarly communications. However, there exists ambiguity about plagiarism in our Universities. Is there any established percentage to determine when plagiarism has taken place? Is there a rule of thumb to determine plagiarism? Are there different types of plagiarism? What may be the consequences if plagiarism is detected? How to avoid it? This workshop is designed to address these problems with pragmatic solutions. Again, the workshop will provide researchers with knowledge and hands-on training on how to use the Turnitin program, enabling participants to check manuscripts and dissertations for signs of plagiarism using a global database of academic publications. Thus, the overall goal of the workshop is to ensure that future academic output, i.e., theses and publications of our universities in Odisha achieve expected quality and reliability standards of high quality journals.
