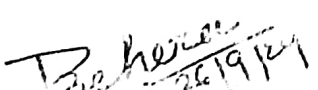

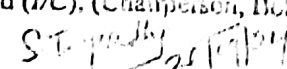
Discussion:

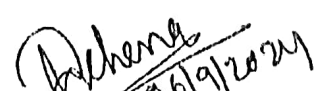
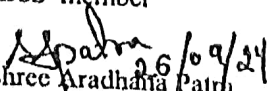
At the outset, the Head of Department (HOD) welcomed all attendees and outlined the objective of the meeting. The HOD then presented the syllabus for the 3- and 4-year B.Sc. (Chemistry) programs, which include provisions for multiple entry and exit points in line with the National Education Policy (NEP-2020), along with the MSc syllabus. The attendees unanimously agreed on the following points:

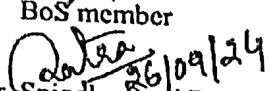
- The B.Sc. (3yr/4yr) programme structure, as per NEP-2020, with provisions for multiple entry and exit options, was accepted without changes.
- For the MSc programme, the marking scheme was revised from 80+20 to 70+30.
- The determination of the Distribution Coefficient experiment may be included in the PG 305 paper.
- No changes were made to the PhD programme.

As there was no other matter for discussion, the meeting was concluded with the above resolution.
