Publication Policy -	Original, unpublished and error-free Man- uscripts on any branch of Indology, review of recently published Indological books, review of earlier issues of SRADDHA may be submitted (in two copies, one in MS word and one in PDF form) for publication by authors of any discipline. The length of the article may be restricted within 5000 words. Each article should be accompanied by an abstract not exceeding 100 words along with key- words.
