Agenda: Review of OCGG activities and way forward.

Discussion and Resolution:

1. A workshop is organized by OCGG on "Human Sleep Rhythm Analysis". All the faculties associated with the centre along with OCGG staffs were participated in this workshop. Professor A.K. Pati and Prof. Arti Parganiha invited as resource person and subject experts. Prof. Pati delivered his lecture on the importance of sleep quality measurement for the elderly population by the Actigraphy measuring device. Professor Arti Parganiha elaborated the application of actigraphy based on output in case of the cancer patients. She also highlighted the challenges faced during her studies.
2. Dr. Monalisa Mohapatra, PI, OCGG has presented the progress of the OCGG.
3. After the presentation, Professor Pati has suggested the following concerns and points:

- a) He pointed out about the slow functioning of the Field work.
- b) Additionally, he emphasized on the fund allocation for the field work, hiring field investigators (~20 numbers) for smooth conduction of the field work.
- c) He suggested to provide the remuneration of (~500/-) per day to the appointed field investigators.
- d) He checked the filled questionnaire and SOP also suggested for an Odia translated version of the questionnaire.
- e) He suggested to finish the socio-economic portion of the questionnaire before going to collect the information on sleep quality measurement.
- f) The sleep quality measurement has to be measured by taking different age groups such as, young (<40, 40-49, 50-59) and elderly (60-69, 70-79, >80) with 30 samples each be studied.
- g) He suggested to take approval of Certificate Course of OCGG from Syndicate members.
