GUIDELINES FOR

VALUE ADDED/ ADD-ON, CERTIFICATE, & DIPLOMA COURSES

- Any new value added course/ Add-on course/ Certificate course/ Diploma Course developed by a Department or School should be placed before the Board of studies, and approved by Academic council.
- 2. The course offered should not be the same as any course listed in the curriculum by the respective programme/ any other programs offered in the University Departments/ Schools.
- 3. Before designing the syllabus, the feedback from employers, alumni, industry and other stake holders should be analyzed and considered for inclusion as far as suitable / possible.
- 4. Classes for value added courses/ add-on courses in particular will be conducted during weekends / vacation periods / beyond the regular class hours so as to facilitate the students of University to enroll themselves.
- 5. A student will be permitted to register for only one value added course in a semester.
- 6. The student may be allowed to take value added courses/ add-on courses offered by other Departments / Schools after obtaining permission from / forwarded through head of the School.
- 7. The credits earned by the students of this University through these courses will be reflected in their University Grade Sheet.
- 8. The students who successfully complete the course shall be issued with grade sheet and certificate duly signed by the authority.
- 9. A nominal course fee subject to a maximum of Rs. 1000.00 (Rupee One Thousand Only) for Value Added / Add-on course to be decided by the concerned Board of Studies may be collected from the students to run the course smoothly.
- 10. The course fee for certificate course and Diploma Course shall be decided by their respective Board of Studies, and approved by authority.
