ABOUT GANGADHAR MEHER UNIVERSITY

Established in 1944 as Sambalpur College, the name of the institution was changed to Gangadhar Meher College in 1949 after the name of the illustrious Oriya poet (Gangadhar Meher). In 1991 the colleges was awarded with the status of an Autonomous College and managed and controlled by statutory and non-statutory bodies as prescribed by the University Grants Commission.

In the year 2015 the college was awarded with 'A' grade by the NAAC, and subsequently was accorded with unitary University status by the Govt. of Odisha. It is situated in the tribal dominated part of Odisha and strives hard for excellence in its way to fulfill its goals and missions since then. Basically, it aims at educating weaker sections, which constitute more than half of the population of the western part of Odisha. From small student strength of 192 in 1944, the institution has made rapid strides over the period of time and has grown into a multi-faculty Post-Graduate University, catering to the needs of about 5500 students. It provides teaching faculties in 20 P.G. Programs, 20 U.G. Courses, 19 M. Phil. Programs, 05 Self-Financing Courses, Ph.D. Programs in 10 major schools with many others Ph.D./M. Phil./ PG/ UG courses/ Programs in the pipeline.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL OF INTEGRATED B. Ed.

The GMU took the lead and started the 4 years integrated B. Sc. and B.A. B.Ed. Programs on self financing mode since 2016. These courses are being run with the approval from the Govt. of Odisha as per the latest NCTE norms. Both these courses have a sanctioned strength of 50 seats each. - An author can submit only one paper. Each paper should comprise of a title page illustrating the title of the paper and the theme/sub-theme under which the paper falls.
- The full paper should be in English, typed in Times New Roman, with a font size 12 and spacing of 1.5.
- Referencing styles should be based on APA 6th Edition.
- All papers should be submitted via Email Id only. No other means of paper submission will be allowed.
- Papers will be selected for presentation at the national seminar through a peer review committee formed in the university.
- Poster presentation will be allowed in case the number of papers is more.
- Confirmation on acceptance of the paper will be communicated to the author(s) via their Email Id.
- The authors have to prepare slides for the power point presentation of the accepted papers.
