As per the decision made in the Core committee meeting, the following guidelines are to be followed for the proper implementation of the Bio-metric Attendance Management System (BAMS) for students of the GMU.

- 1. The BAMS will come into force from the 4th of December, 2019. Attendance percentage will be calculated from the date of opening of the system in the respective Departments/Schools.
- 2. Manual system of Students' attendance is hereby stopped from the current semester. However, for practical classes, HoDs will take manual attendance till an alternative system is put in place.
- 3. Students of each class of all Schools/Departments will have to record their attendance twice daily i.e. on entry and before exit. Every UG student must remain present at least for three hours a day and every PG Student must stay for at least four hours a day. Integrated B.Ed students to stay for at least five hours a day.
- 4. Once entered into the campus of the University and recorded the entry attendance, no student will be given full attendance unless he/she records her exit attendance at the completion of the minimum hours of stay in the School/Department.
- 5. Students are advised to attend all classes regularly and spend time in the Library to enhance their intellectual capability and employability.
- 6. At the end of each month bio-metric attendance record will be collected by the authorized personnel and details of record will be analysed.
- Monthly report of attendance particulars of each student will be generated and students and their parents will be informed through sms.
- HoDs and all the teachers are requested to sensitize students and make them aware about the BAMS.
- 9. No students having attendance below 75% will be allowed to appear the end-term examinations.
- 10. All the students should check the displayed name on the Bio-metric devices after giving their attendance. If any discrepancy is found report the issue to the System Managers.
- 11. No other form of attendance will be accepted.
- 12. Students should not be found outside the class room once the entry attendance is recorded in the bio-metric devices.
- 13. HoDs are to undertake surprise checking of class rooms to make the BAMS effective.
