ABOUT GANGADHAR MEHER UNIVERSITY

Established in 1944 as Sambalpur College, the name of the institution was changed to Gangadhar Meher College in 1949 after the name of the illustrious Oriya poet (Gangadhar Meher). In 1991 the colleges was awarded with the status of an Autonomous College and managed and controlled by statutory and non-statutory bodies as prescribed by the University Grants Commission.

In the year 2015 the college was awarded with 'A' grade by the NAAC, and subsequently was accorded with unitary University status by the Govt. of Odisha. It is situated in the tribal dominated part of Odisha and strives hard for excellence in its way to fulfill its goals and missions since then. The university also gained 12(B) status by University Grant Commission. Basically, it aims at educating weaker sections, which constitute more than half of the population of the western part of Odisha. From small student strength of 192 in 1944, the institution has made rapid strides over the period of time and has grown into a multi-faculty Post-Graduate University, catering to the needs of about 5500 students. It provides teaching faculties in 20 P.G. Programs, 20 U.G. Courses, 19 M. Phil. Programs, 05 Self-Financing Courses, Ph.D. Programs in 10 major schools with many others Ph.D./M. Phil./ PG/ UG courses/ Programs in the pipeline.

ABOUT THE INTEGRATED B. Ed. PROGRAMME

The GMU took the lead and started the 4 year integrated B.Sc. and B.A.B.Ed. Programmes on self financing mode since 2016. These courses are being run with the approval from the Govt. of Odisha as per the latest NCTE norms. Both these courses have a sanctioned strength of 50 seats each. The faculties of the school are striving hard for maintaining quality and fulfilling the goals towards excellence. Presently Dr. (Smt.) Rajashree Baral, Associate Professor of Education is the coordinator (in-charge) of the program, under whose supervision this program is being monitored. Every year national seminar and workshop are organized by the Integrated B.Ed. Programme. One national seminar on "Innovations and Best Practices for Assuring Quality in Teacher Education" was organized; one national workshop on "Action Research in Education" was also organized by the Integrated B.Ed. programme.
