ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Gangadhar Meher University, erstwhile Gangadhar Meher Autonomous College, is a state university located in Sambalpur, Odisha. It was established in 1944 as Sambalpur College, the name of the institution was changed to Gangadhar Meher College in 1949 after the name of the illustrious Oriya poet (Gangadhar Meher). In 1991 the college was awarded with the status of an Autonomous College and managed and controlled by statutory and non-statutory bodies as prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The institution became an university on 30th May 2015. The university also gained 12(B) status by the University Grant Commission (UGC). Basically, it aims at educating weaker sections, which constitute more than half of the population of the western part of Odisha. From a small student strength of 192 in 1944, the institution has made rapid strides over the period of time and has grown into a multi-faculty Post-Graduate University, catering to the needs of about 5500 students. Currently, it is offering 19 UG courses, 22 PG courses, 21 M.Phil & 13 Ph.D programs including 05 Self-Financing Courses. ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The School of Library and Information Science was one of the newly academic programmes of the Gangadhar Meher University which was introduced in 2019. Realizing the importance of library and information science education, research and

practice, Prof. Atanu Kumar Pati, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of the university pioneered the course, with a view to furnish the libraries in the region with vivid and skilled manpower. The department was started under the leadership of retired Prof. Rabi Narayan Mishra to provide the highest standard of teaching and research in order to produce information professionals, well equipped to face the challenges of the dynamic information environment. It is currently offering two years Master level Programme in Library & Information Science (MLISc), One-year Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) and Doctoral programmes in Library and Information Science. The course is designed, keeping in mind the current developments in the field of LIS in India. The syllabus is based on CBCS pattern and provide advanced knowledge on the subject by offering strong theoretical as well as practical classes.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Knowledge, the insignia of the intellectuals, subject experts flow from individual to the institutions and its deposit in the service centres like libraries have become prominent for its effective use by the students, research scholars and the faculties as well of the institutions. A knowledge repository, a podium of aggregation of research outputs of an institution in various forms connotes to an organized set of information system which primarily concerns with capturing, preserving and allowing access to the scientifically organized intellectual output using the software. It facilitates the use of information to excel in learning and research and thus, substantially contribute to expanding the frontier of knowledge. As it is system-oriented, uses communication technology allows remote access and improves research capacity and also promotes collaborative research. This is the collective intellectual output of an institution, recorded in a form that is preserved digitally and exploited. The authors/ contributors and

librarians play a crucial role where the former commits to submit the plagiarism free and published papers and the all the institutional research outputs, the latter promises to reliable access to scholarly journals or research literature with instruction for fair use to the users. However, the onus of designing and development of the Knowledge Repository rests with the librarian.

The Workshop is intended to train the participants with skills for developing their own digital libraries/institutional repositories using open source digital library software (Dspace) and also give awareness about the ethics in academic writings as well as give practical exposure to using anti-plagiarism software.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

The proposed workshop aims to:

- Make aware of the benefits of Knowledge Repository to the scholarly communities as well as plagiarism;
- Understand the role of LIS professionals in the process of designing and development of Knowledge Repository;
- Make the LIS professionals acquainted with planning and designing a Knowledge Repository using Dspace;
- Understand how to handle and involved in installing, administering and customising the DSpace software and
- Give practical experience to the participants in using plagiarism detection software

The target group for the National workshop is the LIS professionals working in college and university libraries, Public libraries, Special libraries like IIM, Medical, NIT etc., Corporate Sector Libraries, Faculties, Researchers and Students.
