





In addition, the Vice Chancellor of G.M. University, Sambalpur, Prof. N. Nagaraju, Chairman PG Council, Prof. Moin Mohamad, Registrar of GMU, Sambalpur, Smt. Jugaleswari Dash, were also present in the meeting and gave their inputs.

The meeting started with welcome address by the chairperson followed by introduction of guests by Dr U.C. Pati. After opening address by the Vice Chancellor of G.M. University. Sambulpur, the draft of Outcome Based Education Syllabus for UG. PG and PhD classes was presented by Dr M.D. Majhi, member of the Board of Studies. After presentation by Dr. Majhi, the matter was made open to the house for discussion.

The following 'suggestions were made by the members of the Board of Studies (School of Economics).

- Shri Sushanta Kumar Guru observed that for enhancing the employbility of students in the
 corporate sector, inclusion of Business Analytics in the syllabus and introduction of Internellip
 right from the UG level will be helpful. He offered the scope for internship at Aditya Alumina
 at Lapanga.
- Dr Sanjukta Das questioned the feasibility of introducing an additional programme of BSc-Economics on the face of shortage of faculty and absence of computer laboratory in the department.

- 3. Prof. Jayprakash Pradhan, recommended initiation of Term Paper of 02 credits and introduction of Field Work Based Project at both UG & PG level. Moreover, Prof. Pradhan also suggested that the field data be applied in Computer Software as hands on experience. His suggestion was that the Project Paper of 06 credits may have the sub-division as follows: Field Works - 02 credits, Computer Applications - 02 credits & Seminar Presentations - 02 credits. This would ensure making labour market ready graduates. Prof. Pradhan suggested for a few changes in the syllabus of PG Programmes such as : Introduction of Gender Studies, Industrial Economics and Statistical Methods in PG-Sem-I and Applied Econometries in PG-Sem-IV.
- 4. Prof. R. Majumdar suggested that Basic Statistics be included in Paper-ECO-104(PG level) with Quantitative Techniques. He also opined the nomenclature of Paper ECO-103 & ECO -203 should be ECONOMICS OF SOCIAL SECTOR DEVELOPMENT instead of Economics of Social Infrastructure and further he suggested for exhaustive syllabus on Economics of Health & Economics of Education in the same paper. His suggestion was that the paper of ECO-105 and ECO-205 be rearranged as Growth Economics & Development Economics separately. According to Prof. Majumdar the freely available Statistical Package R and Python should be inducted in Paper ECO-204 and the Option - C of paper-ECO- 206 should be replaced by papers like Industrial Organisation or Rural Development. For paper ECO- 303 and ECO- 403, Prof. Majumdar opined for inclusion of topics like Climate Change and Energy. Further Prof. Majumdar suggested for inclusion of Gender Economics as an option in the paper ECO-306. He also advocated that the modalities for Dissertation Paper should clearly be defined whether it should be Survey Based or Secondary Data Based/ Viva-Voce or presentation.
- The Mphil/PhD syllabus will remain same without any changes.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. U. C. Pati, Asst. Professor (Economics) and Member of the Board of Studies.

- Prof. Susanta Kumar Das briefed the members about the changes in the syllabus which was also communicated to the members and experts earlier through email. He requested the members to give their inputs with a view of comprehensive revision of the content.

The highlights of the meetings are as follows:

- the fore the start of the meeting Dr. Dutta cleared that this revision is for the interim policy and it is not for the new education policy
- 4. 15. Dutta suggested that the syllabus should be student friently and the advanced topics should be elective, so that those who want to go for higher studies can opt those courses.
- 4 Dr. Dutta also suggested that since the school is offering Quantum Mechanics-I and Quantum Mechanics II in semester 1 and semester 2 as core subject. There is no need of Advanced Quantum Mechanics in Semester 1 as core subject. He further suggested that It can be an elective subject. He also insisted on offering Modern Optics to the MSc students.
- 4 Dr. Datta also misisted on introducing Atomic and Molecular Spectroscopy in place of Advanced Condensed Matter-IL
- Dr. Santosdi Das suggested that the advanced quantum mechanics should be an elective course. He further suggested that nano-photonics and metamaterials can be combined together and can be returned as Modern Optics.
- 6. Dr. Banerji Beliera informed that the advanced condensed matter physics syllabus will be a heavy course for the students. So, he was requested to send the suggested revisions in the course through mail.
- Dr.Bauerji Behera also informed that the publisher name should be mentioned in the syllabus.
- 8. Dr. P. Nayak suggested that there is no need of advanced quantum mechanics as students study Quantum Mechanics I and II as core subjects. He also insisted that there should not be any repetition of the B se course in the syllabus.
- 9. Dr. P.Nayak also suggested that the marks distribution should be uniform i.e equal emphasis on each unit.
- 10. Dr. P. Samal informed in the meeting that Advanced Quantum Mechanics will not be heavy for the students and since this course is there in all universities. It should be a core course for the students.
- 11. Dr. Dutta suggested that the Recent Trends in Physics I, II & III, in the PhD may be renamed as (a) Theoretical Physics; (b) Experimental Physics and (c) Computational Physics. He also suggested that if such changes are made then the syllabus also needs restructuring.

In the meeting it was decided that the syllabus will be revised as per the expert's comments and it will be sent to the experts. After their final approval it will be submitted in the university on 21 September 2020.






