Title of the Research Work: Current scenario and future prediction of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) in Sambalpur City: integrating socio-economic and spatial factors. We are thankful to Prof. Santanu Kumar Patnaik (External Subject Expert) for his valuable suggestions to improve the standard of the proposed Ph.D. research work. The expert's suggestion and the modification in the research approach therein are summarized as below:

Expert's suggestion: Explore the spatial co-relation in the occurrence of disease (NCD occurrence)
and lifestyle pattern.

Scholar's Compliance: We will collect the data on both NCD occurrence and lifestyle pattern of the city dweller to show the spatial correlation ward-wise using suitable statistical measure.

Expert's suggestion: Use stratified random sampling or snow ball sampling to collect data on the lifestyle pattern.

Scholar's Compliance: We will use stratified random sampling in all the wards of Sambalpur city and subsequently categorized them based on their life style. We have planned to address it by taking into consideration dietary preferences, sleep cycle analysis, and activity level of the respondents interviewed through structured questionnaire during primary data collection.

3. Expert's suggestion: Identification of NCD hotspot shall be carried out. To go for.

Scholar's Compliance: We will be accommodating the above suggestion by performing hotspot analysis in GIS environment to show clusters of NCDs in the city using suitable spatial statistics.

4. Expert's suggestion: To employ logistic regression instead of linear regression.

Scholar's Compliance: We will work with logistic regression to show the cause and effect more clearly between various lifestyle indicators and NCD.

Expert's suggestion: Sample size can be reduced. To collect water and air quality samples from each ward.

Scholar's Compliance: We will try though not sure if water quality can be used to correlate with NCD. We will use air quality to find its impact on occurrence of NCD.

Expert's suggestion: To consider not only the population affected with NCD but also the unaffected one to show the difference in lifestyle patterns.

Scholar's Compliance: I will take into consideration all the healthy lifestyle choices of the unaffected individuals to perform a comparative analysis.
