Activity-3: Teaching English Language to Underprivileged Children

Date: 04-01-2024

Aim:

Like many other cities of the state, Sambalpur also has a huge number of slums where children are deprived of basic education. Due to lack of awareness and also due to the paucity of means, parents rarely send their children to schools to avail the benefits of a formal education. Further, the educational training offered in schools often needs to be complimented by practice and training at home. With a view to promoting the cause of

education for the underprivileged children of the slums of Sambalpur, the students of the School of English visited the slum to offer basic practice in English alphabet, words, small sentences, etc. students began by interacting with the children to find out their varying levels of competence. They distributed basic learning materials and aids like slates, chalk, pens, pencils, notebooks, readers, etc to trigger interest among the children. Following this, they imparted lessons in the most friendly and convincing manner.

Activity-2: Local Heritage Awareness: Exploring the Lesser Known Temple History and Culture of Budharaja Temple

Date: 07-10-2023

Aim:

Sambalpur is home to a rich and diverse culture, among which mention might be made of some of the oldest temples of the state. Although Bhubaneswar has become popular as the city of temples, other towns and cities of Odisha also boast of equally old and antique temples that are known for fostering rich culture and tradition of a specific region. With this intention in view, the students of the School of English visited Budharaja Temple, which a less well known temple of Sambalpur. The Budharaja temple has a great history, and was constructed in the 17th century. Students walked to the temple from the university, visited the age-old Budharaja hill, and interviewed the priest to unravel the historical significance of the temple.


Title: TWO-DAY NATIONAL WEBINAR ON RECENT TRENDS IN ANTHROPOLOGY
