Standard Operating Procedure (SoP)

1. The PI is solely responsible for completion and utilization of the Seed fund project within six months from the date of release of 1st instalment. PI may, if necessary, engage a Co-PI. The Audited expenditure statement should be submitted by the PI.

2. The project must be within the sanctioned amount of Rs. 1.00 lakh. Excess expenditure if any will be borne by the PI concerned.
3. The approved fund shall be utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. No diversion of fund is admissible.
4. All faculties sanctioned with seed fund must publish at least two papers in Scopus, web of science and UGC Care listed journals within three to six months.
5. Completion certificate will be issued by the Registrar only after submission of two publication.
6. Already published work, submitted/awarded Ph.D. thesis work, already submitted/ongoing project work can't be considered or covered under this seed fund project. If detected, the PI will have to return the entire amount sanctioned and released against him.
7. The PI may buy books relevant to the project and his field of study not exceeding Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only). Books so bought may be submitted to either department library or central library along with project report.
8. The PI, specially from Social Sciences and Humanities, may also organize a workshop or theme meeting related to the theoretical or methodological requirement of the project.
9. The Books and Equipment purchased from the seed fund shall be entered in the stock register and return same to the University after completion of the project.
10. The contractual faculty members will have to submit an affidavit to the effect that they will not leave the University till completion of the project and in case they leave the University before completion of the project they will have to refund the whole sanctioned & released amount.
11. The first instalment of the grant i.e. 40% of the sanctioned amount, will be released after the Principal Investigator complies with the project grant initiation procedure. The grant will be released to the Principal Investigator.

After receiving the quarterly progress report, statement of expenditure and utilization certificate of the 1st instalment of the grant; the second instalment i.e. 40% of the total grant will be released. The third and the final instalment i.e. 20% of the sanctioned amount will be released only after receiving the following:

- Two hard copies of the final report along with the soft copy.
- A consolidated item wise detailed statement of expenditure incurred during the entire duration of project in the prescribed format duly signed and sealed by the competent authorities of the university/ institution and the Principal Investigator.
- A consolidated duly Audited Utilization Certificate for the amount actually utilized towards the project duly signed and sealed by Govt. Internal Auditor / Chartered Accountant, competent authorities of the University as well as the Principal Investigator in the prescribed format along with statement of expenditure and supporting bills/ vouchers duly signed by the competent authority.
- The unutilized grant, if any may be refunded immediately through demand draft drawn in favour of Registrar, Gangadhar Meher University, Sambalpur, payable at Sambalpur.
- The Principal Investigator through the University is expected to settle the accounts immediately on completion of the project.

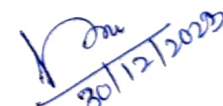

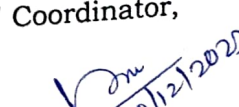
